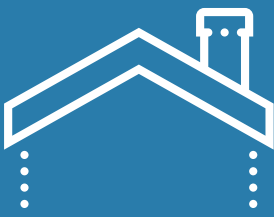


DON'T BE LEFT OUT IN THE COLD: **PREPARE YOUR HOME FOR WINTER WEATHER**

Remove dirt and debris to prevent roof and gutter damage.

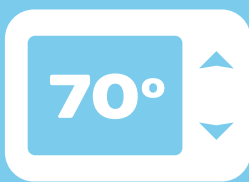


INSPECT AND REPAIR ROOF AND CHIMNEY

INSTALL SMOKE AND CARBON MONOXIDE DETECTORS



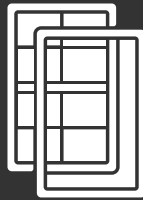
INSTALL EASY TO READ THERMOSTAT

INSULATE AND WINTERIZE

Insulate pipes on exterior walls. Insulate windows by using storm windows and winterize exterior buildings.



Insulate with heat tape, insulation or newspapers to protect your water supply. Allow faucets to drip.



Eliminate drafts with storm windows, plastic, weather stripping and insulation around doors and windows.



Winterize barns, sheds and structures.



CHECK YOUR FURNACE

Have a qualified technician check your heating system and vents.
